Hampton Roads Joint Land Use Study

Attached is a letter from Mr. Patrick J. O'Brien, Director of the Office of Economic Adjustment (OEA) in the Department of Defense to Mr. Larry Johnson, President of the Concerned Citizens Against OLF (Outlying Landing Field).

Commissioners may recall that OEA provided financial support to the region for preparation of the Hampton Roads Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) in 2005. This study effort was administered by the HRPDC staff on behalf of the Cities of Chesapeake, Norfolk and Virginia Beach, and the U.S. Navy.

The Hampton Roads JLUS Technical Committee is scheduled to meet on October 21, 2010 to address the JLUS Study and the potential need to update the Study to address changing issues and accomplishments since 2005.

The Hampton Roads Planning District Commission, working with the Cities of Chesapeake, Norfolk, and Virginia Beach, and the Department of the Navy completed the Hampton Roads Joint Land Use Study in 2005 to address local encroachment at Naval Air Station Oceana, Naval Auxiliary Landing Field Fentress, and Chambers Field.
