2. Sustainable Communities

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has released an Advance Notice for funding for the 2011 Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant program. HRPDC coordinated an application for the 2010 program that did not receive funding. HRPDC staff will brief the Committee on the FY2011 Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant program and application development process.

3. Aquaculture

The General Assembly has formed a study committee to look at local governments' authority to use zoning to manage aquaculture, specifically whether or not to amend the Right to Farm Act (Code § 3.2-300 – 3.2-302) to include aquaculture. The Middle Peninsula Planning District Commission is coordinating data gathering and discussion between PDCs in the Coastal Zone. HRPDC staff will brief the Committee on the recent discussion and events thus far.

4. **Client Survey**

The HRPDC is looking to gather feedback from its member localities, regional organizations, and other stakeholders on its programs and processes as well as ideas for changes or new programs. HRPDC Staff will brief the Committee on the proposed Client Survey initiative.

Pamela Mason, Virginia Institute of Marine Science, will brief the Committee on the use of living shorelines as the preferred alternative for stabilizing tidal shorelines and the guidance for the management of tidal shoreline systems for the regulatory entities.

6. **Chesapeake Bay Phase II Watershed Implementation Plan (WIP) Update**

HRPDC staff will provide the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay TMDL Phase II WIP process. DCR sent the Planning District Commissions responses to several questions that have been raised at previous meetings. The questions and answers are attached.

8. **Rainwater Harvesting Presentation**

VDH and DHCD have published guidelines and building code changes related to rainwater harvesting. These new guidelines and building code changes may limit the use of rainwater and graywater, which could reduce the effectiveness of stormwater reuse as a BMP and may limit reuse as an alternative source of water to meet demand for public water. Dwayne Roadcap, Virginia Department of Health, and Larry Brock, DHCD, will brief the Committee on these documents and answer questions.
