**2. Reality Check**

HRPDC staff will provide a brief overview of the preliminary results of the Reality Check Hampton Roads event that took place on May 17, 2012 at ODU.

**3. Stormwater Regulations and Local Programs Update**

Local government representatives will provide the Committee with an update from the May 17, 2012 Stormwater Local Government Advisory Committee. Materials from the meeting are located here: <http://www.dcr.virginia.gov/lrswlgac01.shtml>. Committee members are encouraged to provide feedback or concerns on the model ordinance or required programs checklist. DCR is accepting comments until June 30. HRPDC staff will be briefing local government CAO's on the revised regulations and the adoption schedule on June 21, 2012. The Regulatory Advisory Panel for the Phase II MS4 General Permit will meet on June 20, 2012. LJ Hansen, City of Suffolk, has been selected as the Region's representative on this panel, but all are welcome to attend. Staff will also discuss comments and representatives for recent regulatory actions on the Construction General Permit and Nutrient Trading.

#### 4. **Sea Level Rise**

HRPDC staff submitted the FY2011 Climate Change report to the Committee via email for its consideration on April 6, 2012. HRPDC staff will lead a discussion on the report and any comments from localities. HRPDC staff will also update the Committee on several related projects in the region. #### 5. **Coastal Zone Management (CZM) Program**

Contingent upon receipt of NOAA funds, the Virginia CZM Program intends to award between three and five grants on a competitive basis to coastal planning district commissions for the FY 2012 grant year (10/1/12 to 9/30/13). The intent of these grants is to provide PDCs the opportunity to address one or more of the five topics prioritized by the Virginia Coastal Policy Team (CPT): water quality, coastal resiliency, working waterfronts, habitat restoration, and public access. HRPDC staff will brief the Committee on CZM grant opportunities and update the Committee on the status of several CZM projects.

**ACTION:** Recommend that the HRPDC authorize HRPDC staff to apply for competitive grants through the Virginia's Coastal Zone Management Program.

#### 6. **Summary of "Opportunities and Constraints for Nutrient Reductions on Private Property" study**

HRPDC received a grant from the Coastal Zone Management program to examine the feasibility of implementing BMPs on private property. Wetlands Watch conducted the study on behalf of HRPDC. The draft report was distributed on May 14<sup>th</sup>. No significant comments were received from the Committee.
