STATE REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ Code of Virginia – 10.1-1411
- ◆ Administrative Code – 9 VAC 20-130, et. seq.
- ◆ Develop Comprehensive & Integrated Solid Waste Management Plan:
 - Each City, County or Town, or
 - Designated Regional Agency
- ◆ Maintain Plan & Update on 5 Year Schedule
- ◆ Achieve Mandated Recycling Rate of 25%

DESIGNATION HISTORY

- ◆ 1991 – Designate Planning Area and Agency
 - Planning Agency – HRPDC
 - Management Agency – SPSA
- ◆ 2004 – Re-designate Planning Agency
 - SPSA
- ◆ 2010 – Proposed Re-designation of Planning Agency
 - To Be Determined

OPTIONS FOR DESIGNATION

- ◆ 16 (Potentially) Local Governments Individually
- ◆ Regional Agency
- ◆ Combination of Local Governments and Regional Agency

ADVANTAGES OF DESIGNATING REGIONAL AGENCY

- ◆ Cost-effective
- ◆ Administratively Simple
 - Public Sector
 - Private Sector
- ◆ Balances Ability of All Localities to Achieve Recycling Rate

RECOMMENDATIONS

- ◆ SPSA Board Recommends Designation of HRPDC as Regional Solid Waste Planning Agency
- ◆ Local Governments Need to Designate Regional Agency
- ◆ HRPDC Staff will Develop Model Resolutions for Local Government and SPSA Use in Changing Designation
