2. Norfolk Flooding Study Presentation

The City of Norfolk has been working on a comprehensive effort to mitigate the impacts of and damage from flooding in the City. These efforts include both planning initiatives and studies of specific infrastructure projects. Norfolk staff will provide an overview of the City's efforts.

3. askHRgreen.org Report

Each year, an annual report is produced summarizing the joint and combined activities of the four environmental education subcommittees that constitute askHRgreen.org. Staff will provide a brief overview of the FY 13 askHRgreen.org annual report and a snapshot of promotions planned for FY 14.

4. Coastal Zone 309 Grant Project Update

HRPDC staff will provide an update to the Committee on the GIS modeling component of the Land and Water Quality Protection grant project. A brief summary of the methods and results will be presented for the subject areas in Norfolk and Suffolk. A draft of the first two deliverables for the project will be made available online before the meeting. The Committee will be asked to approve the final report at the October meeting.

5. Coastal Zone Program Updates

The HRPDC staff attended a meeting of the Coastal Policy Team at DEQ on August 19, 2013. Staff will brief the Committee on that meeting and the progress of various HRPDC-CZM grant proposals for the current and forthcoming fiscal years.

6. Chesapeake Bay Program Update

HRPDC staff continues to follow the developments at the Bay Program related to implementation of the Chesapeake Bay TMDL. One major activity is the addition of new stormwater best management practices (BMPs) to the model through the BMP panel review process. Staff will highlight recommendations from recently approved panel reports and provide an update on the BMP panels in progress.

7. Comments on Proposed Building Code Changes for Rainwater Non-Potable Water Systems

The HRPDC staff has developed draft comments on the proposed building code changes related to rainwater harvesting. Proposed revisions to the code provide for the scope and design of rainwater non-potable water systems. The proposed regulations were published in the [July 29, 2013 issue of the Virginia Register of Regulations](#) (page 3282). The public comment deadline is September 29, 2013.
