Regional Legislative Agenda

- Complementary, not in conflict with local legislative priorities
- Short List of Regional Priorities
- Important to have unanimous support of region's localities

- Chief Administrative Officers (September 6)
- Invite Legislative Liaisons to Regional Legislative Committee Meeting (September 8)
- Mayor/CAO Roundtable on Violence Prevention
- Regional Legislative Committee Prepares Recommendation
- Adoption by HRPDC/HRTPO Boards (October/November)

September 6 CAO Committee Meeting

- We are most successful when we have a short strategic list of regional legislative priorities
- Identify topics that are better championed by other entities
- For instance – Public Safety Items
- Divide our Regional Legislative Agenda into Two Categories
 - Priority Areas
 - Priority advocacy areas
 - Position Statements
 - Monitor and support
 - Monitor and oppose

Recurrent Flooding

- Support the formation of the Chief Resilience Officer Position at the State level with six staff
- Provide a minimum of \$200 million/year through the Commonwealth Flood Protection Program to support smaller projects and planning efforts
- Develop State funding program to provide non-federal match for federal grants to support large-scale projects
- Support need for Peninsula Army Corp Study

Potential Regional Priorities

- Continued Support for Jefferson Lab (Maintain State Funding as Non-Federal Match)
- Support Efforts to Make Hampton Roads a Hub for the Emerging Offshore Wind Industry
- Financial Assistance to Support Shovel-Ready Economic Development Sites

Potential Regional Priorities

- Maintain Full Funding for I-64 Gap
- Support Faster and More Reliable Passenger Rail Service between Hampton Roads, Richmond and the Northeast Corridor
- Adequate Funding for Hampton Roads' Three Transit Providers
 - Regional Transit Advisory Panel
- Continue Efforts to Mitigate Toll Impacts at Downtown and Midtown Tunnels
- State/Federal Funding to Build the Birthplace of America Trail (BoAT)

Potential Priorities

- Provide adequate funding for transportation network maintenance and repair
- Support Housing Opportunities for All
- Reject Unfunded Mandates
- Federal/State Broadband Funding Flexibility
