Have you heard of Sea Jacks? It's a 16-year-old company from Great Yarmouth, England that operates self-propelled jack-up vessels used to install and maintain offshore wind turbines and foundations. They've done more than 500 worldwide and now have a small office at Gather in VA Beach Town Center, presumably to help construct and maintain Dominion's CVOW project. In fact, Sea Jacks is already providing support for the massive half-billion dollar Charybdis transport vessel Dominion is having built in Texas.
