ENDORSE THE HRPDC AS THE LEAD ORGANIZATION TO ADMINISTER THE CLIMATE
POLLUTION REDUCTION GRANT FOR THE VIRGINIA BEACH-NORFOLK-NEWPORT
NEWS METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA**

WHEREAS, the new Climate Pollution Reduction Grants (CPRG) program will provide non-competitive grants to states, regions, and tribes to develop and implement plans for reducing greenhouse gas emissions and other harmful air pollution.


WHEREAS, the Virginia Beach-Norfolk-Newport News, VA-NC, Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) is eligible to apply for the initial planning funding.

WHEREAS, the member communities of the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission are all included in the Virginia Beach-Norfolk-Newport News MSA and would benefit from a climate action plan;


WHEREAS, each MSA must submit a Notice of Intent to Participate that identifies a lead organization that will administer the climate pollution reduction grant;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission (HRPDC), that the Executive Director is authorized to submit the Notice of Intent to Participate to the Environmental Protection Agency identifying the HRPDC as the lead organization for the Virginia Beach-Norfolk-Newport News MSA.
