3. Portsmouth Comprehensive Plan Update

The City of Portsmouth is in the process of updating its comprehensive plan. "Build One Portsmouth" is based around a vision of establishing a thriving, resilient, evolving, and equitable city. The plan is organized into four elements: a strategic plan, a geographic plan, an implementation plan, and a glossary and set of appendices. Mr. Brian Swets, Portsmouth Planning Administrator, will give a presentation to the Committee on the planning process and draft plan.

4. Chesapeake Bay Landscape Professional (CBLP) Certification

The CBLP Certification is a credential program for professionals who design, install, and maintain small, residential-scale stormwater practices. Ms. Shereen Hughes, Virginia CBLP Coordinator, will provide an update on the program. A pilot was initiated in Hampton Roads and the District of Columbia in 2016. The program has since expanded to Maryland and Pennsylvania, and there are now over 150 CBLP-certified professionals.

5. Stormwater Green Infrastructure Study

Mr. Daniel Robinson, recent M.S. graduate of Virginia Tech, will present the findings from his study on identifying the challenges to implementing stormwater green infrastructure practices. Several months ago, Mr. Robinson reached out to the local

MS4 Stormwater Managers for their input using a detailed survey tool. He has compiled these results to present to the Committee. As part of his research, he has also identified some strategies to assist localities in overcoming the challenges.

6. One Water Summit 2018

In July, HRPDC and HRSD staff attended the One Water Summit in Minneapolis, MN. The event was hosted by the U.S. Water Alliances and included discussions on affordability, green infrastructure, smart city development, and other issues.
