

Wellhead Protection Implementation Grants

Since 2005, the Virginia Department of Health, Office of Drinking Water has utilized Environmental Protection Agency Set-aside funds to offer grant opportunities for local wellhead protection implementation projects.

This grant opportunity is available for localities or service authorities who meet the following criteria:

- Own or Operate a Community Waterworks,
- Process Drinking Water Directly From A Groundwater Supply Source,
- Have A Protection Strategy In-Place, **AND**
- Have An Active Source Water Protection Committee

Past awarded projects have included:

- Well Abandonment
- Well Lot Fencing
- Protection Area Delineation
- Advancing Zoning Ordinances
- Emergency Response Planning
- Hazardous Waste Collection
- Educational Outreach
