




State Requirements

- Regional Plan vs. Individual Locality Plans
- HRPDC designated as the Regional Solid Waste Planning Agency in August, 2012
- Maintenance of Plan and Update on 5 Year Schedule
- Achieve Mandated Recycling Rate of 25% (**Actual 30.8%**)

Waste Generation Estimates

- Waste/Person/Year
- 2010 – 1.68 tons
- 2015 - 0.92 tons
- **45% Reduction**



Waste Generation Estimates


Total Waste

2015 – 1.27 million tons by
2035

SPSA Landfill – 30+ years for Cells 6 & 7

Bethel Landfill – 70+ years

Wheelabrator RDF Plant - Long term disposal option

Virginia Beach Landfill & Portsmouth CDD Landfill –
Capacity for 20 year planning period

- Submit the Plan to DEQ for Approval
