HRPDC

- Provides Staff Support to HRTPO
- Recipient of Federal Funds
- Compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964



Title VI

- Prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in any program or activity that receives federal funds or other federal financial assistance

Environmental Justice

- Meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, color, national origin, or income in the development, implementation and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations and policies.

Community Affairs and Civil Rights Department

- Discussions with FHWA and VDOT on opportunities to expand public involvement in the HRPDC's regional planning activities
- New Department will coordinate public involvement for both HRPDC and HRTPO



Community Transportation Advisory Committee

- Formed in 2010
- Works with HRTPO to provide grassroots, community level involvement in the transportation planning process



CTAC

- Up to 30 Members
- Residents of Hampton Roads localities
- Provide community viewpoint



Recommended Action

- Endorse expanding the duties of the Community Transportation Advisory Committee to include both HRPDC and HRTPO activities
