# Potential Legislative Priorities

**Maintain the Region's UASI Program designation and increase funding to the region for homeland security purposes**

# Potential Legislative Priorities

## Support State Funding :

- **Virginia Shoreline Resiliency Fund**  
Low interest loans for flooding mitigation
- **Stormwater Local Assistance Fund**  
Water quality

## **Potential Legislative Priorities**

**Request the new Advisor to the Governor on Coastal Resiliency complete an analysis of existing funding programs and recommend a new funding program(s) that addresses existing gaps**

**Consider new State funding sources to address Chesapeake Bay nutrient reduction requirements**

**Continuation of efforts to provide increased state funding for K-12 public education**



## **Potential Legislative Priorities**

**Support appropriate funding of the Virginia Housing Trust Fund for housing programs and projects that preserve and produce affordable housing opportunities**
