JCSA	No		<i>June 2015 Status Report:</i> The JCSA operates its grease abatement program under the authority provided under Section 19 of our Utility Regulations which states that no person shall discharge or cause to be discharged grease into the public sewer. The program is educational in nature with additional emphasis placed on areas of concern that are identified during routine inspection and pressure washing of the sewer lines. FSE's that are identified as not having a grease trap or interceptor are required to have one installed.
